How are new institutions and policies legitimated? Who or what legitimates? This PhD course introduces and explores how new institutions and policies are legitimated. The purpose of the PhD course is to contribute to PhD training through helping doctoral researchers understand how the institutions and policies that often shape societal behaviours emerge and are legitimated. It explores institutional theory within the umbrella concept of newness, aiding their understanding of the written and unwritten 'rules of the game'.

Participation fee is 300 EUR. Each participant is responsible for his/her own travel and accom-modation.
